Initial diagnosis that would constitute an emergency would be a danger to life such as loss of blood and / or loss of the ability to breathe and /or loss of consciousness, loss of baby's movements or lower abdominal pain followed by backache.

**Please take note:** The above mentioned doctors, specialists, and consultants in their respective specialty are all part of the team, readily available to attend to your medical needs during pregnancy. Please feel free to consult them for any issue arising during pregnancy which is not covered by obstetrician.

### 1. ANTENATAL PLAN OF VISITS

This is a suggested schedule for your antenatal appointment plan, however it may not be strictly adhered to and you should not be worried if it differs slightly.

Visits are paid per appointment. Antenatal visit comprises of appointment with doctor and practice midwife (antenatal orientation)

N.B: You will be seen by Dr Tsitsi Magure at least one of your antenatal visits as it is useful to meet all team members for eventual case of emergency.

Booking form for the hospital (Avenues Clinic, Melbourne Hospital and Borrowdale Trauma) under Dr Djordjevic's name is issued only upon paid deposit for the delivery. That fee covers delivery, including emergency hours, complications of delivery, private nurse care after delivery, visits of the doctor during / after delivery and visits to the rooms during 10 days of post-delivery.

N.B: If you decide to change the place or country of delivery, your deposit will be returned in full.

# Pregnancy is a physiological condition which usually lasts 40 weeks and results in birth of the baby.

In the case of an emergency, during that period, Dr Djordjevic will attend to her clients personally. If Dr Djordjevic is committed to another emergency or absent, Dr Tsitsi Magure will attend to the client and if she is attending to another emergency, Dr Ellen Marere will attend to the patient Hospitals are clearly informed about the contact details of specialist doctors in the team covering emergencies.

Practice midwife will attend to your message and emergency call

Also be aware that although you will likely have a scan at each visit with, scans themselves are not a compulsory component of your antenatal consultation unless there is a perceived risk factor for the baby. If you do not have a scan at an appointment or do not wish to have one, this is perfectly fine. Dr D scans to check on baby's well-being and re-assure you on the steady progress and development of your baby.

When you phone to make an appointment, the practice midwife will advise you accordingly. However, below is an outline of what you can expect and the links that Doctor expects you and your partner to read and make yourselves ready for the next appointments. There are only two visits with scan that are covered by medical aid throughout the pregnancy. Those are second and third trimester anomaly scans and Dr D refers to imaging specialists at Dr Verenga – Fetal maternal Specialist 0784814611/0242708259.

# 2. ANTENATAL VISITS FOR LOW-RISK PREGNANCIES.( HIGH RISK PREGNANCIES WILL BE SEEN BY DOCTOR THROUGHOUT

**8-10 weeks**: this is ideally when you will have your initial consultation. At this appointment, you can expect a scan to confirm pregnancy and you will be sent for blood tests. NIPT is strongly suggested between 8-10 weeks. (See attached referral form and links to read). Counselling is done at the same appointment. It is perfectly acceptable to decline Chromosomal testing, consent form will be given to sign.

**11-13 weeks**: You will have a scan at this appointment and this is the time when a 1st Trimester Chromosomal anomaly test (Trisomy 13, 18, 21) is done, if you didn't have NIPT and a blood test at Lancet. Please read given site information. You will be given a consent form to sign. Bloods are taken to TriScreen Johannesburg and results are expected in 10-14 days later.

**N.B**. The practice midwife shall **ALWAYS** phone and disclose results after Dr has signed them off. If there are any issues, you will be called in to see the Dr.

**16 weeks:** 12 week results discussion. You will be given a 20 week scan referral form for your next appointment with Dr Verenga, fetal specialist. If you haven't done a 12 week Chromosomal anomaly test or NIPT, you will be given a form for Lancet 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester Chromosomal anomaly test, should you wish to have one.

**20 weeks**: You will have "**ANOMALY SCAN**" done by a specialist of fetal medicine. We routinely refer to Dr Verenga.

# N.B\* DELIVERY DEPOSIT TO BE PAID IN FULL BY NOW IN ORDER TO BE ISSUED WITH A HOSPITAL BOOKING FORM

**24 –26 weeks**: A "family-baby bonding scan" with radiographer at our rooms or DIC and you can bring the whole family to see / bond with baby. Optionally a 4D scan is also done by a radiographer – Debbie Martell, at the same time. You can book for that. Practice midwife will check your vitals.

In case you are not having a scan done, please book with practice midwife to do your vitals (BP, urine and weight) at 24 weeks.

**28 weeks:** Antenatal consultation. At this appointment, there will be discussion about expectations and care during the 2<sup>nd</sup> trimester. Glucometer test will be done. 2<sup>nd</sup> trimester links are emphasized

during this appointment. Try to read prior to appointment so that you can interactively participate in discussion. Dr D insists on an interactive mode of consultation. Anti D antibodies will be administered for Rhesus Negative mothers. Referral for GTT will be given. **PLEASE NOTE**: It is advisable to book your GTT with the lab. The GTT is time sensitive and **MUST** be done as ordered.

**32 weeks**: Antenatal consultation. This is a follow up visit with scan for fetal growth and well being

**35 weeks**: 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester anomaly scan with Dr Verenga. He will check on overall fetal wellbeing in particular cerebral medial artery, Doppler and pulmonary artery velocity index (technical terms)

**36-37 weeks**: Standard consultation. At this appointment, there will be discussion about expectations and care during labour, (Birth plan) will be discussed. Vaginal examination and genital swab for Streptococcus B screening will be done. 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester blood test will be requested.

39 weeks: Antenatal consultation.

**40 weeks**: Antenatal consultation, with scan to assess fetal growth and wellbeing If your baby has not come by 10 days after 40 pregnancy weeks, you will be scheduled for an induction of labour.

Post-natal debriefing visit –day 2 or 3 with practice midwife as a part of delivery booking fee and pelvic floor physio. Thereafter with independent midwife (6<sup>th</sup> post-natal class). It is strongly recommended to see a lactation specialist straight after delivery. Please have contact numbers on a visible place.

6 weeks after delivery is your final post-natal visit with your Obstetrician/Gynaecologist. It is perfectly alright to book this visit with your family practitioner. (Family planning discussion). A Pap smear should be taken if no Pap smear was not done in the past years. Pelvic floor exercises are highly recommended as per midwife's / physiotherapist instructions.

**NOTE:** If you have been seen by your family practitioner, it is perfectly alright to stay there for up 24 weeks as Dr D works closely with referring physicians and the same protocol of antenatal care is being followed as a shared care model. If you have been seen in another part of the country, or coming and want to transfer here for delivery, it is perfectly alright to do so. Just bring all your documentation / results with you on your 1<sup>st</sup> appointment with us.

#### 3. MIDWIVES AND ANTENATAL CLASSES (INDEPENDENT)

As part of Dr Djordjevic's model of shared maternity care, it is expected that you will have 4-6 prenatal classes with independent midwives for primi-parous(first time mum-to be) and two classes for multi-parous mums (Labour & Birth) and /or (Baby and Breastfeeding).

- 1. The first class is **The Early Pregnancy Introduction Class** which ideally takes place between 10-14 weeks. However this can be undertaken any time shortly after booking.
- 2. From 30 week prenatal preparatory classes, either:
  - a) As a set of 4 group classes that prepares you and your birth partner for the final stages of pregnancy, the normal labour and birth, the assisted or complicated labour and birth as well as breastfeeding and the care for the newborn baby. Or:
  - b) A choice of 1 or 2 private classes covering 1) Labour and Birth and/ or 2) The Baby and Breastfeeding.
- 3. **The Pelvic Floor and Lower Back Class**: as of 12 weeks, 36 weeks and 6 weeks post natal. Antenatal classes for pelvic floor exercises and preparation for birth are highly recommended. (Jane Du Toit antenatal back physio), (Gyrid Chitombo- pelvic floor physiotherapist).
- 4. 3-5 days after birth **labour debriefing and help** to get started. Physiotherapists are on the same premises as us. (See at the back)

During the course of antenatal period, you will have a minimum of 4 antenatal visits with the obstetrician and monthly midwife/ultra-sonographer check-ups of mother to reassure well-being of the baby. These visits are charged as midwife/ultra-sonographer visits. Charges are at the reception.
